General Instructions: Rules for Abstract Submission

- 1) Abstract Receipt Deadline: **March 15, 2012**
- 2) Accepted abstracts will be printed in the Meeting Program & Abstract Book exactly as you submit it.
Errors and misspelling will be apparent in the published abstracts, so please proofread your abstract carefully.
They will not be edited, retyped, or typeset by the Meeting Organizing Secretariat.
- 3) The first author will be duly notified of Acknowledgment Number as notification of the receipt of abstract by email from the JSGT-Secretariat.
(If no email received within 1 week, please confirm it to the JSGT-Secretariat by email at jsgt@js9.so-net.ne.jp)
- 4) All Abstracts will be reviewed by the 18th JSGT Scientific Program Committee around April 2012.
- 5) Authors will be notified in May 2012, regarding the date, time and form of presentation by email and authors will be accepted for oral or poster presentations.
- 6) All accepted abstracts will be published in the congress issue of the Journal of Gene Medicine (JGM) with the presence of author's consent.

2. Abstract and Application Form must be written in English.

3. Type text single-spaced, in a single paragraph in MS Word format. The required font is Times New Roman or Times with an 11point character type.

4. The entire TITLE should be capitalized (ALL CAPS) except for words in which lower case letters have a specific meaning, such as pH or NaCl.

5. Text must fit within the blue rectangle, exactly as shown here and should not be typed over the blue lines of the box. Please be sure to check errors and misspelling before submitting your paper.

6. Abstract Receipt Deadline: March 15, 2012.
